Materials: Image of wind swirls or blank sheet of paper; colored pens, pencils, crayons, or markers

- Print the attached image prior to Sunday Morning, or have a blank sheet of paper available
- As you listen to the Worship Service, draw something that represents one thing you have done or could do to help someone feel the truth of “You are not alone. I am here.” Or, draw something that represents something someone has done or could do for you to help you feel that truth.

Also included:

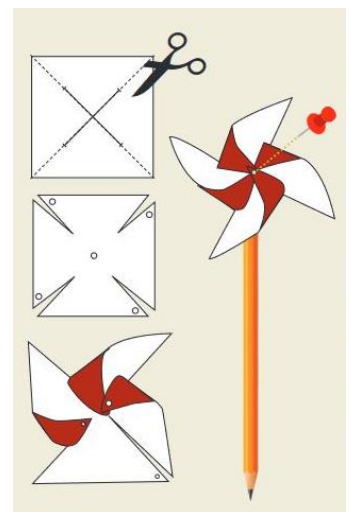
- Coloring pages (Abstract wind shapes, the word Compassion)

Beyond Sunday Morning

Put your faith in action: Connect with someone by taking action to let them know they are not alone. Write and send a card to a friend, give your drawing to a sibling, bake a treat and share it with your family or a neighbor, call a grandparent or older friend... What other ways can you think of to connect with compassion?

And/or: Construct a pinwheel, and every time it spins (via breath or wind), let it remind you that you are not alone, and you have the power to help others know that they are not alone, either.

As you choose how to reach out or create your pinwheel; engage with intention, reflecting on your actions and the notion of being present for others, or what resonated with you from this Sunday’s Worship Service.
