We will discuss reconvening, the General Assembly June 23-27, pose annual questions to the congregation, and discuss leadership opportunities in our congregation for 2021-2022.

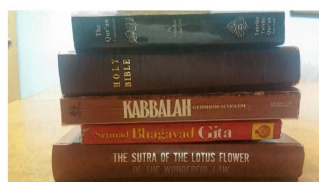
